

RESOLUTION

*Authorization to Proceed with North Broad Street Drainage Improvements
and to Approve Professional Engineering Services*

WHEREAS, the Hogg Engineering Corporation has performed preliminary engineering analysis and cost estimates for storm drainage improvements in the vicinity of 2709 North Broad Street; and

WHEREAS, the initial assessment and conclusion is that the City of Selma replace existing 24-inch and 30-inch driveway pipes from Dawson Avenue north towards 2709 North Broad Street and construct headwalls at each driveway, replace existing inlets, construct concrete slope paved ditches between each driveway pipe and replace concrete driveways demolished as a result of construction; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary cost estimate for the installation of 488 linear feet of 24 and 30 inch concrete pipe, 13 headwalls, 3 inlets, 650 linear feet of slope paved ditches and 100 square yards of concrete driveway is \$83,455.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Selma the City has determined that the proposal submitted by Hogg Engineering Corporation is acceptable based on their experience with sewer and storm drainage projects; and


WHEREAS, Hogg Engineering Corporation is proposing to perform Professional Engineering Services for the project in the amount of \$10,850.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Patrick Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to proceed with the construction of the storm drainage improvements in the vicinity of 2709 North Broad Street for a preliminary estimated cost of \$83,455.00.




